

Cissus rotundifolia

“Peruvian Grape Ivy”

Light/Sun Exposure

- Grow best in bright indirect light (part shade) by a west or east facing corner or window.
- Insufficient light causes the slow-growing plant to stop growing altogether.
- Direct sunlight can burn the leaves.

Watering Instructions

- Water moderately. Drought tolerant so no need to over-water.
- Allow the soil to dry out slightly between watering
- Allow for proper water drainage

Temperature

- Peruvian Ivy does best in temperatures that are steady between 60-80 °F
- Temperatures under 55°F will start to cause damage to the leaves.

* This is a vining plant with evergreen foliage.
